The focus of the project was to make the collection digitally available to the research scholars. We used MARC 21 Format for Bibliographic Data and captured according to the Anglo American Cataloguing rules 2nd edition revised (AACR2R) and Library of Congress Subject Heading (LCSH) standards. This ensured that the client's cataloguing requirements were met and no variations were introduced during the process.
